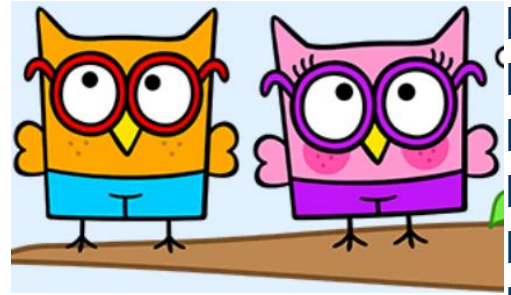

TEACHER MESSAGE

It's lovely to have everyone back and ready for another exciting term of learning. We're looking forward to exploring new topics and building on the great progress made in Term 1. WHAT WE'RE Learning

ENGLISH:



Y1/2: Students will become 'Animal Experts' by engaging with simple informative texts. They will explore how a similar topic is presented in an imaginative text. Students will create a multimodal poster that provides facts about an animal.

MATHS:



Y2: Students will tell time to the quarter hour and use a calendar to locate information. Students will count and represent numbers up to 1 000, locate numbers on a number line and partition numbers using place value.
Y1: Students will count to and from numbers up to 100, locate numbers on a number line and partition numbers using place value.

SCIENCE:



Y2: Students describe and represent the changes to a living thing in its life stages. They compare the life stages of two different living things.
Y1: Students will describe how different habitats meet the needs of living things. They will explain how changes in the environment can affect the needs of living things.

HASS:



Y2: This Semester, students will continue their inquiry to answer the question: How and why have changes in road transport affected the lives of people over time?
Y1: Students continue to identify, describe and sequence personal family events and describe continuities and changes in aspects of daily life over time.

Visual Arts:

Y1/2: Students will create a mixed media poster or diorama of the habitat of an animal of their choosing.
