### Curriculum Overview

**English:**

Students are working towards writing an informative text about a creature. They will be learning to write sentences about what animals and creatures look like, where they live, what they eat and how they move. Students will also be reading, viewing and comprehending informative texts.

**Math:**

Students are continuing to learn how to show one- and two-digit numbers in different ways and solve addition and subtraction problems to 20.

**Science:**

Students will consolidate their learning on the basic needs of plants and animals, and describe how the places they live meet those needs.

**HASS:**

Students will be exploring different family celebrations as well as look at how aspects of daily life have changed over time.

**Visual Arts:**

Students will be designing and making a mixed media artwork and/or diorama for the habitat of an animal or creature.
