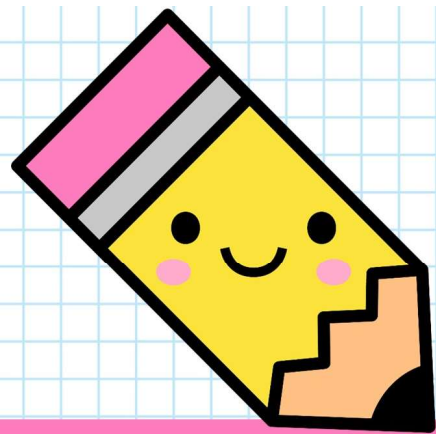

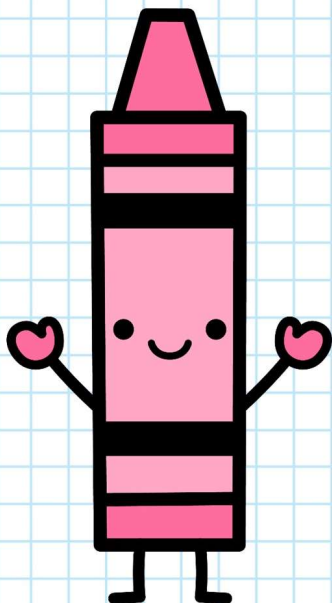

What are we learning this term?

English- Students are learning to write a recount of a familiar imaginative text. They will listen to familiar cultural stories and discuss the characters, settings and key events. Students will read, view and comprehend an imaginative text.

Mathematics- 1B will Partition collections into equal groups and skip count in twos, fives or tens to quantify collections to at least 120. They will use numbers, symbols and objects to create skip counting and repeating patterns, identifying the repeating unit.

Science- Students will describe objects and events that they encounter in their everyday lives. They will describe changes in the local environment and respond to questions and sort and share observations.

HASS- Students will conduct an inquiry to investigate places and their features at a local scale.

Design technologies- 1B will create a musical instrument by using skills of investigating, generating designs, producing, evaluating and managing.
