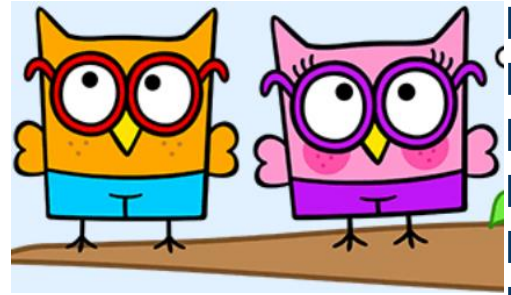

### WHAT WE'RE

## Learning

#### ENGLISH:



Students will explore celestial objects in the night sky and create their own informative poster using both written and visual features. They will read and view a range of texts to build their understanding of the topic.

#### MATHS:



Students will work with numbers up to 999, learning to partition, regroup and rename them to support addition and subtraction problems, including real-life money situations. They will also read analogue clocks to the hour, half hour and quarter hour, and use calendars to explore the number of days between events.

#### SCIENCE:



Students will explore and learn about celestial objects in the sky, including the Sun, Moon and stars. They will also identify and describe simple patterns they can observe, such as day and night and changes in the night sky.

#### HASS:



Students will continue to investigate and develop a poster about how road transport has changed the lives of people over time.
