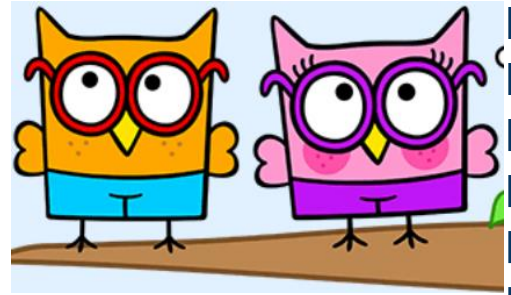

WHAT WE'RE

Learning

ENGLISH:



Students read, view and listen to a variety of literary texts to explore how characters are represented in print and images. Students identify character qualities in texts. They compare how similar characters are depicted in two different literary texts and write a text expressing a preference for one character, giving reasons.

MATHS:



Students recognise the features of three-dimensional objects and they draw two-dimensional shapes. They explain the effects of one-step transformations. Students perform simple addition and subtraction calculations using a range of strategies.

SCIENCE:



Students use the story of the Three Little Pigs to investigate the characteristics and properties of materials, and the suitability of materials for a variety of uses. Students conduct investigations into the characteristics and properties of materials, and they use their findings to inform the design and production of a shelter that will withstand the 'huffing' and 'puffing' of the Big Bad Wolf.

This term, students will continue the inquiry to answer the question: **How and why have changes in road transport affected the lives of people over time?** They will create a poster to share their understanding.
