YEAR 5B TERM 4 OVERVIEW

MATHS

Number & Place Value, Patterns & Algebra: Students will explore complex number patterns and learn how to use algebra to find unknown values.

Location & Transformation: We'll be investigating maps and grids, focusing on using coordinates to locate and transform shapes.

Shape & Geometric Reasoning Students will dive deeper into the properties of shapes and practice reasoning with geometry.

Health

Students explore the concepts of health and wellbeing and the idea of healthy habits as a preventative measure.

ENGLISH

In English, we will be focusing on persuasive writing. The students will create a persuasive text on a person they believe is the "Greatest of All Time" (GOAT). This will provide an opportunity for them to improve their persuasive language and structuring skills.

SCIENCE

Students will describe the key features of our solar system, including the planets and stars. They will examine key developments in space exploration and contributions to our knowledge of the solar system.

HASS

In HASS, we'll be diving into consumer decision-making. Students will learn about the importance of understanding the difference between wants and needs and how these influence the decisions we make every day.

Technology

Students will develop data from Pokémon and create a spreadsheet that allows them to present that data in different formats.



THE ARTS

Students will focus on representations of animals as companion, metaphor, totem and predator.
