What Are We Learning?

English

Students will create an informative text to report on a fictionalised creature. They will write about what their creature looks like, how it moves, where it lives and what it eats. 1C will draw their creature and label the features. Further, students will read, view and comprehend a simple informative text.

Math

Students will count to and from numbers up to 100, locate numbers on a number line and partition numbers using place value.

Science

1C will describe how a habitat meets the needs of a living thing and how changes in habitats might affect living things.

HASS

Students will identify, describe and sequence personal and family events and describe continuities and changes in aspects of daily life over time.

The Arts

Students will explore sense of place through imaginative experimentation with a range of materials and processes to design a mixed media poster or diorama of the habitat of an animal or fictionalised creature.
