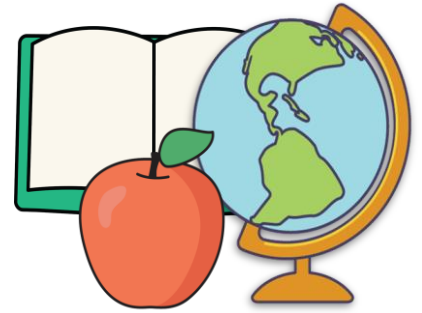

I have been a teacher here at Oxenford for the last 10 years. 2025 will be my 36th year of being an early years teacher and I am very excited to have the privilege of supporting your child along their Year 2 learning journey. I'm looking forward to all the fun times we are going to have together.

WHAT WE'RE Learning

MATHS:

Students will collect, organise and represent data to make simple inferences. They will explain the effects of one-step transformations and interpret simple maps of familiar locations.

ENGLISH:

Students will give a speech about their favourite character. They will learn how language is used to convey actions, emotions and dialogue. They will share ideas and express an opinion about a familiar character and their traits.

THE ARTS:

Students will respond to, perform and choreograph dance moves that represent a character by exploring characters in stories and rhymes as stimulus.

SCIENCE:

Students will design a toy car that moves with a push or pull, and describe a change to the car and how it affects its movement. They pose an investigation question and make a prediction about the car's movement.

HASS:

This Semester, students will conduct an inquiry to answer the question: *How and why have changes in road transport affected the lives of people over time?*
