**Under the agreement for 2015
Oxenford State School will receive**

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standards in Reading in Year 3 from 88.8% to 92.5%
- Improve Teacher and Teacher Aide capabilities through instructional leadership processes and professional development to improve students' performance
- Develop an Individual Learning Plan for students who are below the National Minimum Standard
- Refine and strengthen the Oral Language Program for Prep – Year 2

Our strategy will be to

- Review student data on a 5 week cycle
- Further develop the existing Oxenford State School Reading Program to include daily one-on-one reading practices for all students in P – Year 2
- Introduce a Numeracy Intervention Program (NIP) targeting identified needs of students in Prep – Year 2, with a core skills focus

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Create a professional development program around Data analysis that supports individual teachers in Prep – Year 2 to build their capacity	\$20,200
• Employ an additional Prep teacher to maintain minimum numbers across all Prep classes	\$75,000
• Employ and train teacher aides to support classroom teachers with their Reading and Oral Language program	\$45,000
• Purchase resources to support programs	\$15,000
