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# What are we learning?

#### English

This term, in English, students will share ideas and retell familiar stories and express their opinion on their favourite Bluey episode, using a small number of details from text/film. They will sequence ideas and use language features including topic-specific vocabulary and features of voice. 1C will participate daily in Oxenford State School phonics code for Year 1 and English warm ups. Students will receive time to work independently and with teacher/teacher aide guidance in literacy rotations.

#### Math

In Math, this term, students will collect data by asking questions, they will draw and describe data displays and make simple inferences. Students will give and follow directions to familiar locations. 1C will participate in math mentals and place value activities daily, as well as independent and teacher guided math groups.

#### HASS

This semester, in HASS, 1C will identify, describe and sequence personal and family events. They will also explore the continuities and changes in aspects of daily life over time.

#### Science

In Science, students will describe the effects of changing a material to make a boat that floats. We will make predictions, participate in a guided investigation and record and share what we have observed.

### The Arts-Drama

This term, student will devise, perform and respond to drama using a picture book as a stimulus. More information to come regarding props.
