## Our initiatives include

- Strengthening teacher understanding and knowledge of the Australian Curriculum.
- Embedding a strong focus on literacy demands across all curriculum areas.
- Using Early Start data to inform programs and practice in the Early Years.
- Using the Literacy continuum to improve student learning outcomes.
- Support the employment an extra teacher to conduct STEM lessons for Year 3 to 6.
- Releasing teachers in year level cohorts for planning, 3 levels of planning.
- Support student learning and wellbeing through targeted strategies.
- Increase Speech Language Pathologist allocation to support students in the early years.
- Supporting the School Chaplaincy Program.
- Purchase assistive technology resources to support Inclusive practices across the school.
