Dress Code – Oxenford State School

Rationale	<p>Research shows that school uniforms have the following benefits for students and communities:</p> <p>School uniforms promote equality, encourage discipline, build school identity and pride, reduce time and stress in the mornings, enhance safety and minimise distractions for students.</p> <p>The following Oxenford State School student uniform policy consists of an agreed standard and items of clothing between the P&C and school community.</p>
School Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oxenford State School polo shirt• Oxenford State School sport polo• Navy shorts or skorts (no bike shorts)• Oxenford State School hat only• Socks – white only• Long pants or leggings – navy• Oxenford State School fleece or jumper only• Shoes – black closed in shoes or runners (no hi-tops) Acceptable Examples: 
Accessories	<p>Hair has to be managed for health reasons during school hours. Hair requirements at Oxenford State School are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shoulder length hair or longer should be tied up• Hair ties and fixings should be school colours (maroon or navy)• No dyed hair• Hair styles should be neat, tidy and respectful <p>Jewellery is strongly discouraged at school for health and safety reasons. Exceptions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Ear studs or sleepers only - acceptable examples below:- No facial or body piercings  <p>Makeup, fake nails and nail polish are prohibited at Oxenford State School.</p>
Sun safe	<p>Oxenford State School enforce a “No Hat – No Play in the sun” rule. This means that students not wearing any kind of suitable hat will be instructed to move to a shaded area.</p> <p>All students are expected to wear an Oxenford State School hat.</p>
