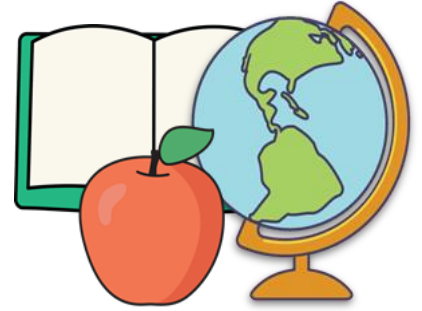

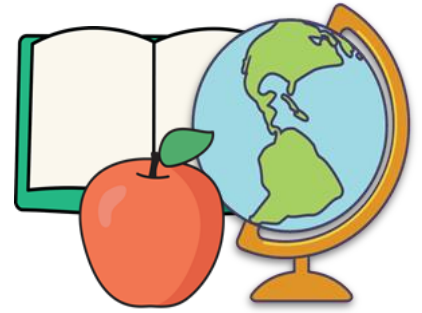

WHAT WE'RE *Learning*

MATHS:

Teen Numbers/Chance/Length

Students recognise, model, write and order numbers to 20, locate numbers on a number line and partition numbers using place value.
Students classify outcomes of simple familiar events.
Students measure and order objects based on length using informal units.

ENGLISH:

Poetry and Rhyme

Students engage with a variety of texts that are rhyming in nature. They listen to, read, view and interpret spoken, written and multimodal texts.
Texts may include picture books, various types of stories, rhyming verse, and poetry.
Students read and share their understanding of a familiar poem. Students share their favourite poem.

SCIENCE:

Material Madness

Students describe the effects of physically changing a material to make a boat that floats. To make a prediction, participate in a guided investigation and record and share observations.

HASS:

My Changing Life

Students identify, describe and sequence personal and family events and describe continuities and changes in aspects of daily life over time.

THE ARTS:

Dance

Students explore movement, music, rhythm and dance. Students learn to sequence movements to perform a simple dance routine.

TECHNOLOGY:

Students use their scientific knowledge of materials to design and create a boat that floats.

HEALTH:

Personal, social and Community Health

Students describe changes that occur as they grow older and recognise how strengths and achievements contribute to identities.
