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WHAT ARE WE LEARNING:

English:

Students will engage with a variety of texts for enjoyment. They listen to, read, view and interpret spoken, written and multimodal familiar poems and rhymes.

Students will create an innovation of a known poem (written) and express a preference between two poems to a familiar audience (spoken).

Math:

Students will describe number patterns and identify missing elements. They will interpret simple maps of familiar locations. Students will associate collections of Australian coins and notes with their values.

HASS:

Students will explore the location and significant features of places and consider how people are connected to these and why they should be preserved.

Science:

They describe how Earth's resources are used and the importance of conserving resources for the future of all living things. They use informal measurements to record observations from experiments.
